Communication and Language

- Two channelled attention-listen and do for a short span
- Understand humour, nonsense rhymes and jokes
- Build up vocabulary reflecting their experiences
- Use talk to organise and sequence ideas and events

We will be talking about stories, rhymes and past events and learning to concentrate for longer periods of time

Literacy

- Describe main story settings
- Enjoy a range of books
- Continue a rhyming string

We will be listening to stories linked to the topic and exploring mark making through play

Mathematics

- Show an interest in number problems
- Show an interest in representing numbers

We will be sorting and counting items and beginning to record our findings

Physical Development

- Travel with confidence and skill
- Hold a pencil between thumb and two fingers
- Use equipment safely

We will be making obstacle courses and having opportunities to dance

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Welcome and value praise
- Confident towards other children
- Accept the needs of others taking turns

We will be talking about other peoples feelings and working together in groups

Understanding the World

- Describe special times or events
- Talk about why things happen and how they work
- Show skill in making toys work by programming or controlling them

We will be exploring and experimenting with programmable toys and talking about special events in the community

Things to do at home!

- Visit the local library to choose a new book to read at bedtime
- Make a story box with different props linked to a favourite book
- Look out for numbers on the journey to nursery!

Expressive Arts and Design

- Use tools for a purpose
- Begin to move rhythmically
- Build stories around toys

We will be learning songs and dances linked to stories, exploring colour shape and size and role play linked to stories
