Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you all for your continued understanding during these uncertain times.

We have made the following adaptations to how we run the school to ensure that everyone can be kept as safe possible:

1. All access and collection of children to the Hive and Nest will be via the school playground.
2. All ladybirds children will be signed in and out on the door.

(These measures are to limit the number of people entering the school building at any one time.)

3. Any children with a new cough or a temperature will be sent home. Government advice from yesterday (16.3.2020) is that the whole family should self isolate for 14 days (not 7 days) <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/>
4. We have cancelled the sing and sign planned for the end of this term.
5. We continue to ask parents to please call the school regarding **any** absence so we can keep a log of reasons for absence.
