Thank you all for the speedy collection of your child/ren from school today as we announced that we have unfortunately been informed of a positive case within our school community.

We hope that the below information supports you in understanding what this means for your child.

Your child/ren needs to self-isolate for 7 days. School will hopefully re-open on 8th December but please check the website for the latest information. From the 1st December, Tapestry will have daily challenges for your child to enjoy. The website has a variety of stories, songs, exercise times and other learning opportunities.

What is self-isolation?

Self-isolation is when you do not leave your home because you have or might have coronavirus (COVID-19).

How to self-isolate:

Your child must not leave your home.

Your child cannot go to school or public places.

Your child cannot go on public transport or use taxis.

Your child cannot go out to get food and medicine – order it online or by phone, or ask someone to bring it to your home.

NO visitors in your home, including friends and family – except for people providing essential care.

Your child cannot go out to exercise.

When to get a test:

Get a test as soon as possible if you or your child develops any symptoms of coronavirus during this self – isolation period.

The symptoms are:

a high temperature

a new, continuous cough

a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste

The test needs to be done in the first 8 days of having symptoms.

If the test is positive, you must inform school ASAP.

You do not need to get a test if you have no symptoms or if you have different symptoms.

Information:

It's a legal requirement to self-isolate. You could be fined if you do not self-isolate.
