## Two locations for Rapid Result COVID-19 Community Testing in Kingston

As part of our response to the COVID-19 pandemic and in light of the high number of coronavirus cases in the borough, I would like to invite you to attend for a rapid result COVID-19 test at one of our new Community Testing sites in the borough. There is one at Kingston University, and a new test site at Chessington Sports Centre. This testing is for key communities in the borough, including anyone who is part of the primary school community in Kingston or who provides key services in the borough, and who **doesn't** have coronavirus symptoms. The test takes about 10 minutes and provides a result in 30 minutes. Details of this testing offer are:

### ***Rapid result testing for key community members at the new Community Testing Sites.***

#### **Site 1:**

**Kingston University, Main Building, Penrhyn Road, Kingston upon Thames, Surrey KT1 2EE**

Dates: from 02/01/21. You will need to wear a mask and follow strict social distancing measures.

Dates: from 04/01/21. You will need to wear a mask and follow strict social distancing measures.

**If you or anyone in your household does have coronavirus symptoms** (a high temperature, new, continuous cough, loss or change to your sense of smell or taste) then you should self isolate and book a test through the standard COVID-19 test booking site: [www.nhs.uk/coronavirus](http://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus) or by calling 119, and follow advice of NHS Test and Trace.

If you or any members of your household receive a positive COVID-19 result you will need to have a confirmatory PCR test and you must self-isolate for 10 days from the date of the test. our household and support bubble will also need to self-isolate immediately and stay at home for 10 days. There is help available if needed, for things like shopping and medicine collection, if you don't have a nearby friend or trusted neighbours.
